Students must demonstrate either Spanish or Portuguese language proficiency for the major.

- Students may take one of the following UCSD courses to demonstrate proficiency:
 - Spanish LTSP 2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, 2E or Portuguese LIPO 1D/1DX, 15, 16, 17
- Petition to waive the requirement by studying abroad for a semester in a Spanish/Portuguese speaking country through PAO (either EAP or OAP).
- Taking a placement test through Linguistic Language Program (LLP)
- Completing high school in a Spanish/Portuguese speaking country

Coursework

All courses for the Latin American Studies major or minor must be taken for a **letter grade**. The exception: LATI 199, which can only be taken ‘P/NP’, can be applied to the major/minor. As an interdisciplinary program there is a possibility that there may be a course with Latin American content offered through a department that is not on the approved course list. Should a student wish to take a course outside of the approved course list, they should contact you **before** the quarter begins for petitioning information.
