

The Latin American Studies Program offers an Honors Program to those students who have demonstrated excellence in the Latin American Studies Major. Successful completion of the Honors Program enables the student to graduate "**With Highest Distinction**," "**With High Distinction**," or "**With Distinction**," depending upon their performance in the program.

Eligibility Requirements

- > Junior or Senior Standing. (90 units to be completed prior to the program's start date)
- Latin American Studies Major GPA must be at least 3.5, and the overall GPA must be at least 3.2. These GPA requirements must be maintained until graduation.
- > Must have completed all lower-division requirements and at least six upper-division courses by the end of spring quarter prior to the program's start date.
- Must submit a half page statement with a description of your research topic along with a ten-item bibliography with this honors application.
- Must obtain a faculty advisor to work with prior to the start of the Honors Program. (If needed, the Undergraduate Coordinator or the Director of Undergraduate Studies will help refer you to an appropriate faculty advisor for your project.)

Program Requirements

Fall quarter, students take LATI 199, *Individual Study*. Winter quarter, students take LATI 190, *Senior Seminar*. Distinction levels are determined by the grade received in LATI 191, *Honors Seminar*.

To graduate "With Highest Distinction" the student must earn an **A+**; To graduate "With High Distinction" the student must earn an **A**; And to graduate "With Distinction" the grade must be an **A-**.

Please note that if a student receives a B- or below in LATI 191, no departmental honors will be given.

Seminar Descriptions

LATI 199 – Individual Study Guided and supervised reading of the literature on Latin America in the interdisciplinary areas of anthropology, communications, economics, history, literature, political science, and sociology. For students majoring in Latin American Studies, reading will focus around potential topics for senior papers; for honors students in Latin American Studies, reading will culminate in formulation of a prospectus for the research thesis

LATI 190 – Senior Seminar Research seminar on selected topics in the study of Latin America; all students will be required to prepare and present independent research papers. Honors students will present drafts of senior research theses, of **no less than fifty pages in length**.

LATI 191 - Honors Seminar Independent reading and research under direction of a member of the faculty group in Latin American Studies; goal is to provide honors students with an opportunity to complete senior research thesis to be defended before three-person interdisciplinary faculty committee.

The completed application must be submitted to the Undergraduate Coordinator. GPA's (both overall and in the major) will be calculated upon student's graduation.
